

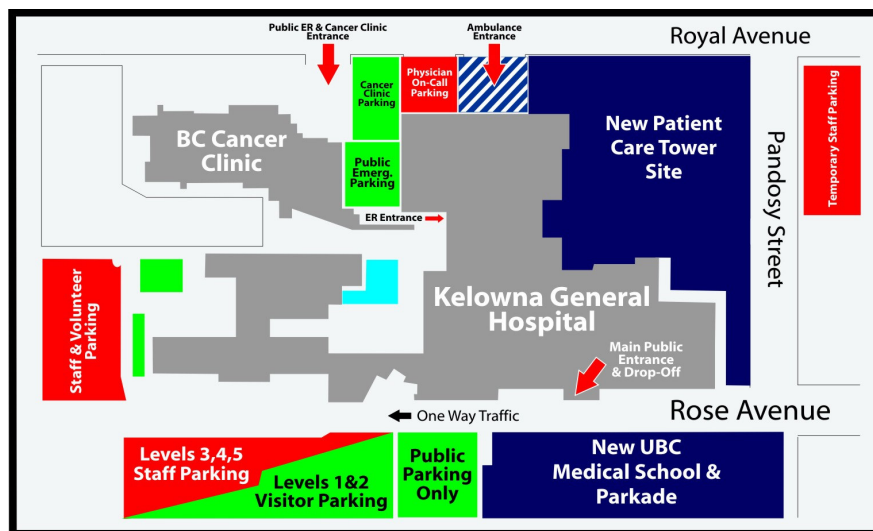
Kelowna General Hospital Site Update

Site Activities at KGH as of March 4, 2009

Patient Care Tower

The pre-load material is all but gone from the site of the new patient care tower at Kelowna General Hospital. If you drive by the site today, you will see the large machinery being set up to start the vibra-densification of the ground where the tower will sit. That work should start by the end of the week and the fencing off of the construction site will continue.

As a result of the construction, the present main entrance to the hospital lobby and emergency department from Pandosy (both patient walk-in and ambulance drop-off entrances) will be moved as of **March 16**. The new main hospital entrance will be at the south end of the hospital on Rose Ave. just west of Pandosy St. The new ER entrance and after-hours patient entrance will be moved to Royal Ave. between the main hospital and the Cancer Centre.



UBC/Parkade

Construction of the UBC/ Parkade building is well under way and the builder is now preparing to pour concrete for the walls. Work took place last week to hook up water, sewer and utilities from the main KGH site to the new building, and Rose Ave. is now open again to one way traffic from Pandosy St.
