Clinical Academic Campus Opens in January

Construction of the University of British Columbia Faculty of Medicine & Interior Health Clinical Academic Campus (CAC) at Kelowna General Hospital is now complete. Interior Health and UBC staff are now preparing to move into the CAC over the next 4-6 weeks.

We would like to take this opportunity to inform all KGH site staff about what the CAC will be used for, who will be working in the building, and what the rules and processes are for public access to the building.

- The **KGH Library** and staff will be moving into the new space in the southeast corner of the first floor of the CAC on or about **December 16**.
- **UBC Southern Medical Program (SMP) Postgraduate Rural Family Practice Residency Program** staff will move into their new offices on the first floor during the week of **December 21**.
- **UBC SMP Undergraduate** staff will move into their new offices on the second floor during the week of **January 18, 2010**.
- The **lecture theatre** and the **UBC large videoconference room** will remain under construction for the first half of 2010 while the audio-visual system is installed. The lecture theatre is expected to open in **Fall 2010**.
- The two small **UBC videoconference rooms** will open in **February 2010**.
- The **UBC clinical skills and clinical resource rooms** on the second floor will be open in **January 2010**.
- **UBC students, out-of-province students, and residents** will begin using the CAC in **January 2010**.

- The first floor of the CAC will be open to the public from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Mon to Fri**, beginning **January 4, 2010**. The second floor will be open during the same hours beginning **January 20, 2010**.
- Access cards for all KGH staff will automatically be programmed to allow 24-hour access to the main entrance and the library, beginning **February 1, 2010**. The lobby will be accessible to the public 24 hrs/day, 7 days/week to allow access to and from the parkade.
- Access to all videoconference rooms, undergraduate administration area and clinical skills/resource rooms will be available through the 2nd floor receptionist who will be on duty during business hours. After hours access will be available by designated key or access card.
